Writer, folklorist, columnist and TV essayist, Roger Welsch is at home with adult audiences from farmers to professors, doctors to golf course managers, in any area of the nation. Time and time again, Roger has been told by audiences that they have never learned so much while laughing so hard. Roger Welsch makes people laugh and think at the same time.



Welsch has taught most of his life at universities and colleges in Nebraska. In 1988, he walked away from a full professorship in English and Anthropology at the University of Nebraska to live and write on his small tree farm near Dannebrog, Neb. A short time later, Roger's old friend Charles Kuralt invited him to become a part of CBS's prize-winning show, *Sunday Morning*. When asked if he misses teaching, Roger replies, "I'm still teaching -- but now my class has 12 million students -- and I don't have to grade papers!"

The author of more than 25 books, including the best-selling *It's Not The End Of The Earth But You Can See It From Here*, Roger is also founder and curator of the National Liars Hall of Fame. His other real passion? It's restoring old Allis Chalmers tractors.
