This letter is a follow up to my meeting with you on February 3 to discuss possible funding for water projects for the City of Cawker City. On behalf of Kansas Rural Water Association and USDA Rural Development, I appreciate the opportunity to meet with all of you.

We discussed the water main that lies under Hwy 24 and the possibility of moving it to the highway right-of-way as well as the replacement of some valves and hydrants and some of the water mains in the city.

We discussed several areas of funding including the KS Department of Commerce Community Development Block Grant program, the KDHE State Revolving Loan fund, and USDA Rural Development ARRA loan/grant program. We also discussed present and future water and sewer rates and funding for the preliminary engineer report. The governing body will need to seek an engineer and grant writer.
