Dear Jerry,

I enjoyed visiting with you recently concerning the monitoring the city must conduct under the Stage 2 DBPR. You confirmed that the city did not begin monitoring in the second quarter last year, but has recently contracted with Continental Analytical Services, Salina.

You should collect samples according to the IDSE Monitoring Plan approved by EPA. If one of the monitoring months was March, then you can still collect a sample this quarter and complete all monitoring by the end of 2010.

I suggest contacting Kelly Kelsey, KDHE Bureau of Water, to negotiate a new sampling schedule and due date for the city's Initial Distribution System Evaluation (IDSE) report.
