I visited with you and Councilman Danny Potts about how the sewer improvement project was progressing on June 21, 2010. You mentioned that the sludge had been removed and that the issue with easement for the lift station had been resolved.

You questioned the need for the third cell since population is declining and the school is closing. I believe these issues have been considered by your engineer and KDHE. The school could be used as another function, such as a business or apartments, and does need to be considered for flow due to the size of building in the scope of the project.

The entire project -- the third cell, lift station and collection system improvements, etc., will need to be constructed as designed and approved by KDHE. This project should provide the City of Emmett many years service with some routine maintenance of the lift station and collection system. King Construction, your contractor, has many years of experience building these type projects and your system should feel at ease as the have provided quality work.
