Re: Stage 2 DBPR Monitoring

Dear Ron,

This letter is simply to confirm our phone conversation yesterday on the remaining monitoring that KDHE will be requiring the city to conduct to comply with the Stage 2 DBPR Rule.

The city will not be allowed to use the data from the March 2009 samples, but will be allowed to use the April 2010 data (2<sup>nd</sup> quarter) and September 2009 data (4<sup>th</sup> quarter). Consequently, dual set samples still need to be collected before the end of July 2010 (3<sup>rd</sup> quarter) and then in January 2011 (1<sup>st</sup> quarter). As you know, when collecting samples you need to collect both TTHM and HAA5 samples at two locations – your POE near the connection with Burlington and Richard Snider's home. We then need to use all quarterly data to prepare the city's IDSE Report which is due to KDHE by March 1, 2011. Please let me know if you need help with this report. Actual compliance monitoring will not start until October 2013 and the city will be back to using the KDHE lab.
