RE: Applications for Water Right Change

Dear Kurt:

Thank you for meeting with me yesterday and allowing me the opportunity to assist you and the City of Washington.

Enclosed are the completed applications for approval to change the points of diversion that we reviewed. These applications request that the three authorized wells be described under the water rights as a battery of three wells, thus requiring only one water flow meter, as required by the recent meter order of the Chief Engineer.

Please review these applications again for accuracy. If they are acceptable to you, sign the signature pages in the presence of a notary. There are also maps attached to the applications that require signatures under the statements that all wells within ½-mile of the geographic center of the battery have been shown on the maps.

A check in the amount of \$200.00 is required for the applications to be accepted. The check should be made payable to the Kansas Department of Agriculture. Mail the signed applications and check to the Division of Water Resources, 109 SW 9th Street, 2nd Floor, Topeka, Kansas 66612-1283.
